

## For those who are driving

There is good information about parking on the web at [www.chicagoparkingmap.com](http://www.chicagoparkingmap.com) or [www.grantparkparking.com](http://www.grantparkparking.com). If you are driving in from the South, please be aware that the Dan Ryan (90/94) is under significant construction which may add 20 minutes into your trip. Once you have parked, you can walk to the CTA "green line" above-street-level trains that run along Lake and Randolph Streets. Follow the signs to make sure to get on the train going to Harlem/Lake: Other trains share the tracks. Note on the photo below that the word Harlem is in Green on the front of the train. The platform also has a green sign showing the destination. You will also see overhead signs and many maps at stations and on the trains. Once you have arrived at the south stairs of the Ashland stop, Union Park is clearly right in front of you.
