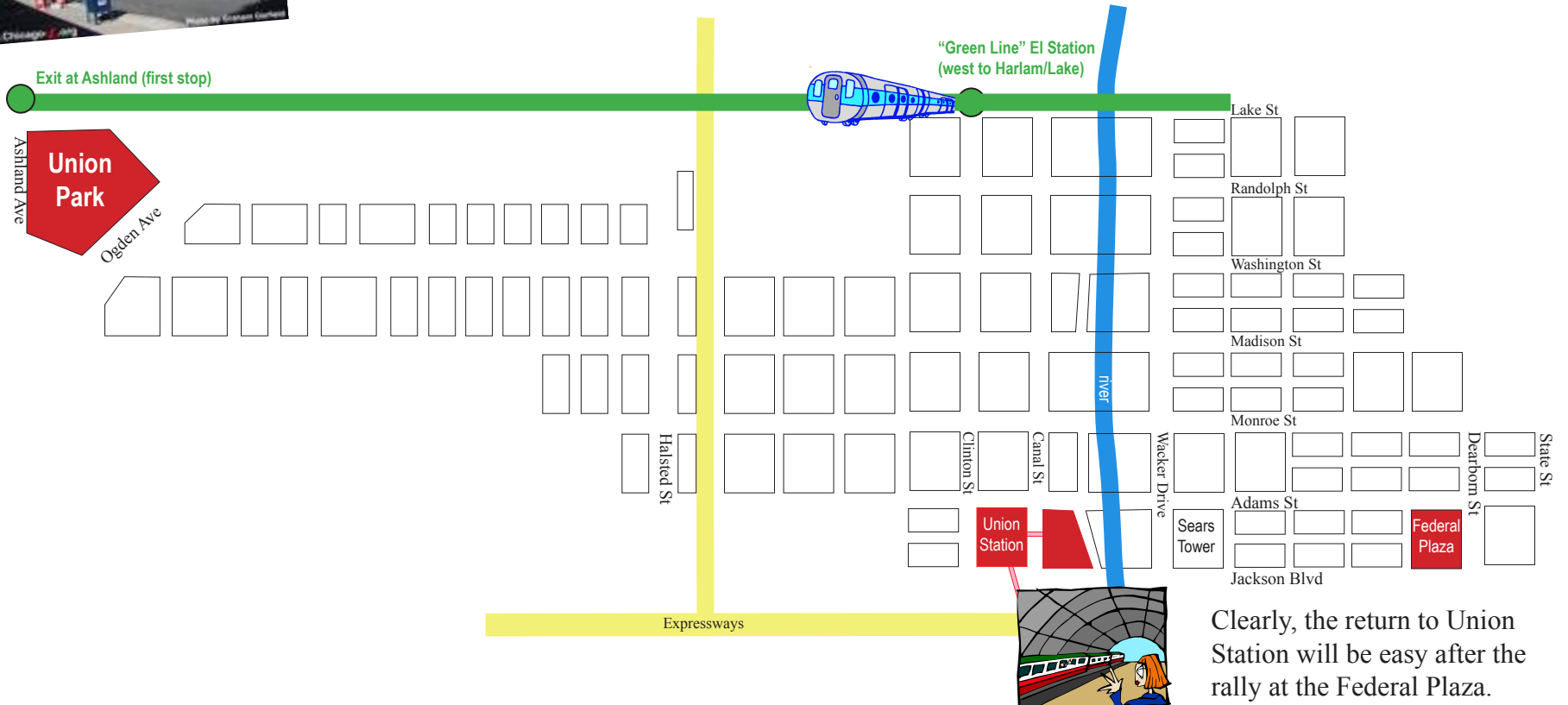


**For those arriving at Union Station**

The walk from Union Station is 1.7 miles. You can cut a mile out of the walk by going to the CTA “green line” train at Clinton and riding to the Ashland stop (\$2). As shown below, once you have arrived at the SOUTH stairs of the Ashland stop, Union Park is clearly right in front of you.

There are other options (buses or the “pink line” train, even closer to Union Station.) However, if you are not familiar with the city, you probably want to take a good look at the system maze at [www.transitchicago.com](http://www.transitchicago.com) which also provides information about **accessibility stations and phone numbers** you can call to confirm that accessibility elevators are functioning.
